## Phil 2:12-13

The Philippians \_\_\_\_\_ regardless of Paul's presence.

## Phil 1:27-28

One way we let our \_\_\_\_\_ be worthy of the gospel of Christ is to obey Him.

**John 14:15-18** *If you love Me, keep My commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever — 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.* NKJV

If we love Jesus we will keep His \_\_\_\_\_.

**Phil 2:12-13** *Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; 13 for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.* NKJV

Work out – “to work out (Latin efficere), i. e. to do that from which something results; of man: make every effort to obtain salvation.” (Thayer's Greek Lexicon, PC Study Bible)

**2 Cor 4:17** *For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.* NKJV

Our light affliction works to \_\_\_\_\_ an eternal weight of glory.

**2 Cor 7:10** *For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.* NKJV

### **Phil 1:9-11**

**Gal 5:22-26** *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. 24 And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.* NKJV

These are not attributes that we can obtain if we work really really hard. They are produced in us if we live and walk in the Spirit.

### **John 15:1-8**

Jesus provides us with the ability to bear fruit. Without Him, we can't do anything!

**Eph 2:8-10** *For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.* NKJV

We are saved by grace through faith. We are not left on our own to get faith. God provides us with evidence that will produce faith in our hearts.

### **2 Peter 1:2-**

We are to be diligent to have a good character.
