Jesus did not hesitate to tell His disciples that He loved them.  We need to verbalize our love for our wives on a basis.
Practical suggestion – tell your wife you love her at least three times a day. Try to say it in unique and unsuspecting ways.

<b>John 13:2-5</b> And supper being ended, the devil having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray Him, 3 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, 4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. 5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. NKJV
Jesus knew that God had given Him all authority, yet he didn't use His authority to get the disciples to wash feet.
Jesus served His disciples, the ones He loved.
<b>1 John 3:16-18</b> By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. 17 But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? 18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth. NKJV
We should lay down our lives for our We should meet her needs.
A re-write of Phil 2:3-4 might look like this, "3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem his better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of your <u>wife</u> . NKJV
<b>Gen 2:18</b> Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him." ESV
God did not make woman to serve man but to man. Help him how? Help him do what?
<b>Prov 31:23</b> Her husband is known in the gates when he sits among the elders of the land. ESV
Acts 18:24-27 Ideally, your wife is helping you in your work.
Practical suggestion – Have a discussion on how the tasks around the house should be divided up. If this is a sensitive issue at your house, you might need help or method that takes the emotion out of the topic.

<b>Hebrews 7:23-25</b> Also there were many priests, because they were prevented by death from continuing. 24 But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. NKJV
