## Lesson's from Rehoboam's life

2 Chron 11:4 - Our faith is by our obedience.
2 Chron 11:13-15 - The priests, the Levites, and those who their hearts to seek the Lord, moved to Judah and strengthen Rehoboam's kingdom.  Rehoboam's kingdom was strong for three years they walked in the way of David and Solomon for three years.
2 Chron 12:1 - Sometimes people the Lord when everything is well. We also learn that leaders sometimes lead the people away.
<b>2 Chron 26:16</b> But when he was strong his heart was lifted up, to his destruction, for he transgressed against the Lord his God by entering the temple of the Lord to burn incense on the altar of incense. NKJV

2 Chron 12:6-8 - God decided to use Shishak, king of Egypt, to Rehoboam for his sin.

<b>1 Kings 11:9-10</b> So the Lord became angry with Solomon, because his heart had turned from the Lord God of Israel, who had appeared to him twice, 10 and had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods; but he did not keep what the Lord had commanded. NKJV
<b>1 Sam 13:14</b> But now your kingdom shall not continue. The Lord has sought for Himself a man after His own heart, and the Lord has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the Lord commanded you." NKJV
