Ruth served Naomi

Ruth 1:16-18 But Ruth replied, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God. 17 Where you die I will die, and there I will be buried. May the Lord deal with me, be it ever so severely, if anything but death separates you and me." 18 When Naomi realized that Ruth was determined to go with her, she stopped urging her. NIV			
Ruth served Naomi by providing her when she was lonely. The first line of defense against loneliness is the physical family.

May the Lord make the woman who is coming into your home like Rachel and Leah, who together built up the house of Israel.
