

# Worship in Heaven

**Neh 9:5-6** *Stand up and bless the Lord your God Forever and ever! "Blessed be Your glorious name, Which is exalted above all blessing and praise! 6 You alone are the Lord; You have made heaven, The heaven of heavens, with all their host, The earth and everything on it, The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You. NKJV*

Nehemiah and the people, in the middle of their worship, acknowledged that the host of heaven \_\_\_\_\_ God.

**Luke 2:13-14** *And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: 14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!" NKJV*

Those who have been in the presence of God praise and glorify Him \_\_\_\_\_ they are.

**Rev 7:9-12** - God deserves worship because He \_\_\_\_\_ us.

**Ps 19:9-11** *The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. 10 More to be desired are they than gold, Yea, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. 11 Moreover by them Your servant is warned, And in keeping them there is great reward.* NKJV
