### Hezekiah understood who God was

**2 Chron 30:9** - Hezekiah knew God is \_\_\_\_\_ and merciful. He knew God would forgive them if they returned to Him.

**2 Chron 32:7-8** - Hezekiah knew that God is willing and able to \_\_\_\_\_ His people and will fight for His people.

In 2 Kings 19:4 Hezekiah refers to God as "The \_\_\_\_\_ God."

**2 Kings 19:10** - The king of Assyria knew that Hezekiah \_\_\_\_\_ in God.

**2 Kings 19:15-19** - Hezekiah knew that his God was the \_\_\_\_\_ God and the one who created everything.

**Isa 45:5**- It is very important to God that His people recognize that He is the only God and there is **no** other.

### Hezekiah obeyed God

### Hezekiah trusted God

**2 Kings 18:22; 2 Kings 19:10**

### Hezekiah prayed to God

The Bible records three of Hezekiah's prayers that God answered the way Hezekiah wanted them answered.

**2 Chron 30:17-20**

Hezekiah prayed that God would provide \_\_\_\_\_ for all who prepared their hearts to seek God even though they had not been sanctified according to the law.

**Isa 37:14-20 ; Isa 37:21-22**

Hezekiah asked for God to deliver him from the hand of the Assyrians.

**2 Kings 20:1-6 -**

Hezekiah turned his face to the wall, \_\_\_\_\_, and prayed for God to save his life.

**2 Chron 30:21-27**
