

# Lessons from the Psalms

## I'm righteous... No I'm not...

### Ps 7:8-10

David asked God to judge him according to his \_\_\_\_\_ righteousness and integrity. He says the Lord saves the \_\_\_\_\_ in heart.

### Ps 18:20-

These words were spoken by David after God \_\_\_\_\_ him from the hand of Saul. David dealt honorably with Saul. He showed Saul mercy twice by \_\_\_\_\_ killing him when he had the chance. ### Ps 26:1-

### Ps 9:12

### Ps 25:8-10

# Learning and teaching humility

## Ps 34:1

Verse 1 says we should bless and \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord.

Verse 2 says we should \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord.

Verse 3 says we should \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord and \_\_\_\_\_ His name together.

Verses 4 and 10 talk about \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord.

Verses 5, 6 and 7 deal with \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord.

**Ps 10:4** *The wicked in his proud countenance does not seek God; God is in none of his thoughts.* NKJV

The proud person does \_\_\_\_\_ seek or think about God.

**Phil 2:3-4** *Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.* NKJV

Humility consists of esteeming \_\_\_\_\_ better than ourselves.

One way we demonstrate humility is to \_\_\_\_\_ the interests of others instead of yourself.

**John 13:2-6** *And supper being ended, the devil having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray Him, 3 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, 4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. 5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.* NKJV

Jesus showed His humility by washing the disciples' \_\_\_\_\_.

**Ex 32:30-32** *Now it came to pass on the next day that Moses said to the people, "You have committed a great sin. So now I will go up to the Lord; perhaps I can make atonement for your sin." 31 Then Moses returned to the Lord and said, "Oh, these people have committed a great sin, and have made for themselves a god of gold! 32 Yet now, if You will forgive their sin — but if not, I pray, blot me out of Your book which You have written."* NKJV

Moses demonstrated humility by asking God to forgive the people.

**Rom 12:16** *Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.* NKJV

Humility can also be seen by associating with the \_\_\_\_\_.
